Any Person misbehaving for any reason will be escorted from the Showground

Horses are not allowed to be tied to horseboxes on showground. Do not muck out horseboxes on showground.

RIDERS ARE STATING THAT THEY ARE FIT TO RIDE BY MAKING AN ENTRY.

**The Organisers accept no liability for any accidents, loss, etc. to anyone on the Showground

**Health & Safety: The Organisers take reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all people and horses present. Everyone must also take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must follow the instructions of the Organisers, Judges and Stewards.

Spectators should avoid the horse areas, especially those with small children.

NO Long whips. Hair to be secured at collar length for any jumping classes.

Novice/child riders must not ride in the warm up area without adult supervision. No liability will be accepted by the organisers if children ride unaccompanied. Practice jumps to be jumped with red wing on the right. Riders not following this rule will be eliminated from their class. Please inform all children of this rule for safety.

Any rider, in the opinion of the judges, misusing a whip will be eliminated from the respective class at any show as in accordance with BS Rules.

Class 5: Pick A Test - Elementary 44, Medium 63 or 71.

Entry Fee: Section A: £13 per class or £24 for 2 classes for same horse/rider combination.

Prize: £10 voucher for Brendon Saddlery to winner, Rosettes 1st-5th.

Entries close Thursday 5pm, will accept late entries if spaces available, telephone to check. Pick-a-test classes - Riders may enter more than one test in a class. **Please state on entry form which test.** Whips and Commanders Allowed in all tests.

SOUTH EAST REGION CHAMPIONSHIP AT HICKSTEAD.

You can qualify for this Championship by being placed 1st or 2nd in Preliminary, Novice and Elementary Tests. Dressage at Hickstead run this Championship and the request riders from BD Group 5 and above to ride at only Elementary Championship. If you qualify please ask secretary for form.

ALL CLASSES TO BE HELD IN INDOOR ARENA 9.30am Start

At this show riders and ponies/horses can dress up in all classes – xmas theme or any fancy dress. Normal competition wear is still acceptable as well. All entries on the day.

Class 1A: **Marvellous Mare** -. Any sized mare, open to all ridden non lead rein.

Class 1B: **Marvellous Mare** -. Any sized mare, open to all lead reins and in hand.

Class 2A: **Gorgeous Gelding** - Any sized gelding, open to all ridden non lead rein.

Class 2B: **Gorgeous Gelding** - Any sized gelding , open to all lead reins and in hand.

Class 3A: **Pony Club Pony** – Non lead rein. (approx 11.30am) Small x-poles jump included and bending cones.

Class 3B: **Pony Club Pony** –Lead rein. Bottom hole trot over x-poles jump included and bending cones.

Class 4: **Best Bay, Brown, Black, Chestnut** - Open to all. Will be split into lead rein and non lead rein/in and if sufficient entries.

Class 5: **Best Grey, Coloured Any Other Colour not in Class 4!** - Open to all. Will be split into lead rein and non lead rein/in hand if sufficient entries.

Class 6: **Best Rider** - Open to all ages. (approx 1pm) May be split if sufficient entries. Canter in individual show optional.

Class 7: **Best Rider** - Lead Rein Only. Judged on rider ability.

Class 8: **Dog Fun Class** – Open to all children with a dog. Small obstacle course (adults can assist!). Treat prize to the best dressed dog. (no pony needed for this class) Entry Fee £6

Class 9: **Obstacle Ride & Run** - Simple obstacles for pony and rider including bending cones, mug on pole, riding through barriers, trotting poles. Rider then dismounts and finishes over obstacles including hoops, under and over, tunnel. Open to all. Fastest time wins. Will split in age groups if enough entries.

Class 10: **Clear Round Jumping**. Small x-poles and then raised higher on request. Pay on day at secretary

Entry Fees: Class 1-7, 9 - £7 per class. Class 8 - £6 per class.

Rosettes to all competitors in all classes.

No group cantering in any showing classes. Canter in individual show optional.

Lead Rein classes are suitable for disabled competitors who are most welcome.

If insufficient entries some classes may be amalgamated. General Brendon Pyecombe Show Rules Apply.

UNAFFILIATED JUMPING – 10am **IN INDOOR ARENA - SATURDAY JANUARY 3RD**

- Class 1: **CLEAR ROUND** - Bottom Hole Mini x-poles. £5, collect ticket from secretary.
Rosettes to all clears.
- Class 2: **MINI X-POLES.** Bottom Hole Mini x-poles. All double clears will receive 1st rosette.
Entry Fee £7
- Class 3: **X-POLES.** All double clears will receive 1st rosette. Entry Fee £7
- Class 3: **0.50m - OPEN** - some straight poles. No spreads, can be led. Entry Fee £7
- Class 4:** **CLEAR ROUND** - Approx 1'6-1'9. Not before 12pm. £5, collect ticket
from secretary. Rosettes to all clears.
- Class 5: **0.60m OPEN** (approx 2'). Open to all. Entry Fee £7
- Class 6: **0.70m-0.75m OPEN** (approx 2'3-2'6). Open to all. Entry Fee £7
- Class 6: **0.80m-0.85m OPEN** (approx 2'3-2'6). Includes fillers. Open to all. Entry Fee £8

All classes with separate jump off.

All classes will be double clears equal 1st.

Refusal Faults: 1st and 2nd refusal – 4 faults each. 3rd refusal =elimination.

Fall of horse or rider: Judge will advise if allowed to remount and finish course but will incur elimination.

All entries on the day Café and saddlery shop open all day on show days.

Please note no paramedic in attendance at these shows so no paramedic charge applicable.
