Table A Two rounds not against the clock, all those clear in round one will go forward to round two over a shortened course. Speed 325mpm. All double clears share =1st. 128cms to jump 1m, 138cms to jump 1.05m. 2 double clears qualify for Alexanders Horseboxes British Showjumping Scope Festival 2013. Pony/Riders are not eligible to compete in this class before the calendar year of which their eighth birthday is reached.

All Entries must be correct on the Entry Form, with British Showjumping numbers or will not be accepted.

Entries only refunded if notified by 9am Show Day. No entries refunded during show under any circumstances. Classes will be CLOSED when full;

ANY CLASS JUMPED AND NOT ENTERED FOR WILL INCUR £5 SURCHARGE PER ENTRY.

All Riders, Owners, Horses, Ponies must be registered with British Showjumping except for Ticket to Rides.

The Organisers and Judges decision is Final, and reserve the right to Refuse an Entry /alter Classes

Any Person misbehaving for any reason will be escorted from the Showground

Please leave dogs at home though we realise this is not always possible please clear up any dog foul and take home with you. Last year we had a major problem with dogs attending shows, if this continues unfortunately we will have to ban all dogs from showground.

Horses are not allowed to be tied to horseboxes on showground. Do not muck out horseboxes on showground.
