#### **DIRECTIONS:**

**From North:** M23, then straight onto A23, past Hickstead. Approx 2 miles, next turn off, A273 to Hassocks, Pyecombe. End of slip road turn right, then immediate left so you go over bridge. End of bridge turn left .

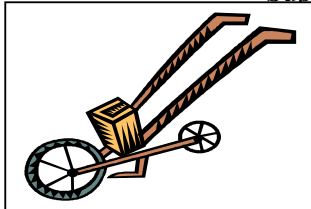

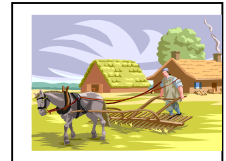
