SUSSEX AIR AMBULANCE

Sussex was one of the few counties in the UK that did not have its own dedicated Helicopter Emergency Medical Service - HEMS, but due to the generous support of the people of Sussex a new service was launched in June 2007.

The new Sussex Air Ambulance is based at Dunsfold Park, on the Sussex, Surrey border and is now flying, fast, direct and unhindered at over 150 miles per hour to reach the whole of the county within a couple of minutes.

It has a crew of highly trained doctors and critical care paramedics on board, who can treat and assess the patient at the scene of the incident and then transport them to the nearest major hospital or specialist unit, in a fraction of the time taken by a land ambulance. It costs 1.5 million a year, or £4,000 a day, to operate the service.

As the charity is funded almost entirely by public donations, support from the people of Sussex is essential to keep it flying, 7 days a week, 365 days a year and give us all peace of mind should we ever need it. Since the launch of the service in June 2007 the crew have flown 1,200 missions and saved lives by saving time.

We will be collecting for the Sussex Air Ambulance today, in the Secretary's Office.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- All horses and ponies to be aged 5 years and over on day of show.
- Practice jumps will be flagged. They must only be jumped with RED flag on the right.
- Hard hats which comply with current Pony Club and BS safety standards must be worn correctly fitted at all times when mounted. Any competitor found wearing a hat which does not comply may be refused entry.
- Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a Doctor's or Vet's certificate or in the event of cancellation by the organiser, £2 will be retained for administration costs.
- This is an Unaffiliated competition judged under BS rules.
- Objections to be made to the secretary, in writing with a £10 cash deposit within 10 minutes of the end of the class concerned. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld. The Judges decision is final.
- The organisers reserve the right to divide, cancel or alter the times of any class, or to refuse entry without giving reasons and amend prize money (if applicable) according to entries.
- **Health and Safety.** Riding is a risk sport. Competitors taking part do so at their own risk. The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all officials and stewards.
- No responsibility is accepted for anything that may happen from any cause whatsoever to competitors, spectators, vehicles or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Organisers and all officials and stewards against legal action arising from an accident.
- To keep classes flowing, any competitor not presenting themselves ready to start in their declared **will** be moved to the bottom of the declaration list.
- Please use the rubbish bins provided. Individuals seen dropping litter on the show site are liable to be asked to leave the site.
- Entries must be accompanied by the correct fee and will be limited.

Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will result in the Competitors being asked to leave the showground and entries will not be refunded.
